



Gillions Farewell Viewing Package

When you choose Gillions to look after the final arrangements for your loved one you are provided with the comfort and assurance that they will be looked after from the time we transfer them to our care until the time we take them to the crematorium. At all times their dignity will be maintained.

Gillions Farewell Viewing Package includes:

- Meeting with you in our offices within business hours (see reverse) to make the arrangements and complete all the required documents and paperwork.
- Transfer from the place of death to Gillions premises.
- Provision of standard mortuary care (embalming if required, washing, dressing and casketing) for your loved one.
- Supply of a standard sized farewell viewing casket (fully lined and with carry handles)*.
- One family farewell viewing time in our viewing room (in business hours and within 48 hours of the transfer to our care).
- Occupancy of our specialised cool room until the cremation is scheduled.
- Attendance on the medical referee and, once permission has been granted, the arrangements with the Dunedin City Council for the cremation will be confirmed.
- Transfer to the Andersons Bay Crematorium. If required, we can arrange this to be at the conclusion of the farewell viewing time so that you may follow over to the crematorium.
- Payment of the cremation certificate and the DCC cremation fee.
- Insertion of a newspaper notice and a listing on our on-line notice platform (notice price is additional).
- Registering the death and supplying a death certificate.
- Your loved one's ashes will be returned to you to a simple cardboard container.
- Access to our wrap-around bereavement support.
